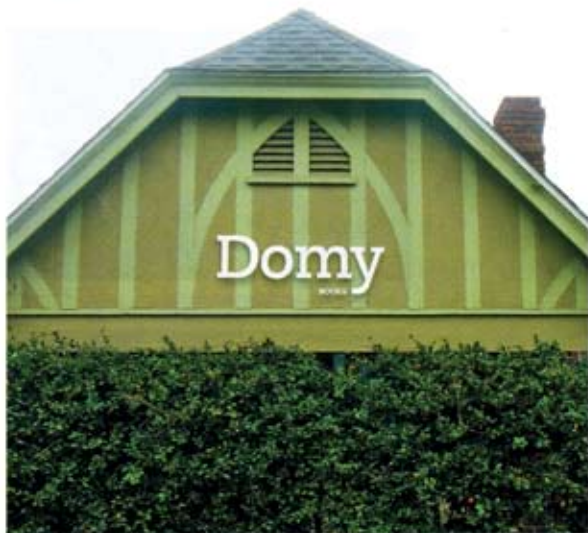

Dan Fergus, owner of the hip haunt Brasil, transformed the bungalow—the former home of Mixture Gallery—into a slightly different sort of venture. In his new vision for the space, Fergus focuses on editioned books and contemporary art, but also carries an edgy assortment of zines, videos, toys, accessories, and gifts.
