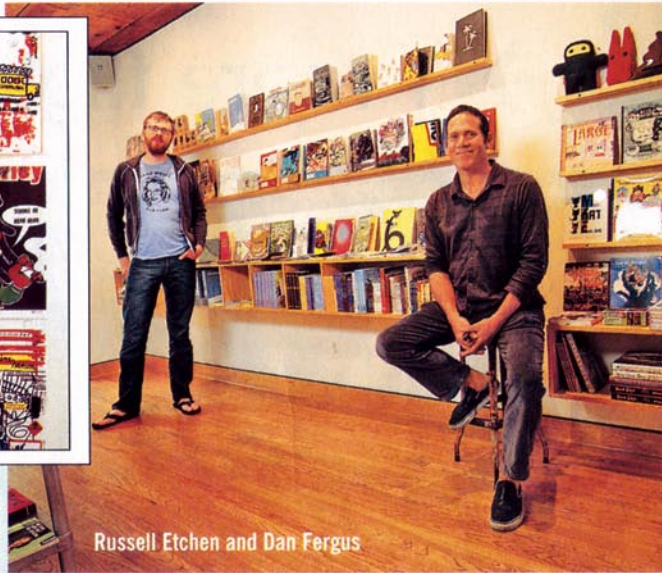

What's on the Shelves: Sayeg and Fergus have amassed an artful compilation of books and magazines devoted to contemporary art and culture at Domy Books — a name derived from a Russian slang term for “home,”

according to manager Etchen. Also displayed in the thoughtfully spare space are uncommon flicks on DVD, such as the fashion documentary devoted to the life of Yves Saint Laurent (one we first saw screened at the MFAH), plus collectible toys and neat silk-screened tees, including a few by Houston artists such as Yar!

and Seth Alverson (\$30 each). Budding collectors searching for compelling artwork for their walls can purchase prints and drawings from Domy's ever-changing gallery of up-and-coming area artists, making this cleverly curated bookstore and shop unlike anything in town.
